At Douglas Valley we grow an abundant selection of organic produce.

During the growing season, farm members visit weekly to pick-up vegetable shares, cut fresh flowers and enjoy the tasting house and farm. Members purchase a share in the early spring and for 12-16 weeks, receive a selection of fresh organic produce grown right here in Manistee.

WHAT IS A CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture is based on a partnership between farmer and consumer. This mutual commitment begins with members purchasing “shares” before planting time and the farmer using the money to purchase seed and supplies. In return for your investment, members receive a basket full of produce once a week June-October.

HAREVST POTLUCK OCTOBER 6TH

At the end of the season member are welcome to bring the family and join us on the farm for a community potluck. This is a great opportunity to get to know all of the other members and have a great time. There will be u-pick apples, pumpkin patch, hay rides, a hay maze and more!

MEMBERSHIP

HOW IT WORKS: The CSA runs approximately 12-16 weeks mid/late June through October. Each week you will receive a generous portion of fruits and vegetables fresh along with a newsletter with tips and recipes.

SHARING: We strongly encourage splitting a share with friends, family or neighbors!

FULL SHARE \$450:

Great for a family or enough for 2 and extra for canning or freezing! You can expect 1 bushel of produce per week. We will try to include a bag of salad mix or lettuce most weeks. You can expect around 8-12 different veggies/fruit each week.

HALF SHARE \$275:

You will receive 1/2 bushel each week ranging from 6-8 different veggies/fruit along with lettuce.

SINGLE SHARE \$180:

This option is great for the occasional vegetable lover or single person. This share will have 4-6 different veggies/fruit and consist of single serve portions.

VACATION SHARE \$25:

If you vacation in or near the Manistee area you may purchase a single week, which amounts to 1/2 bushel, for \$25. (Must specify you week.)

FALL SHARE \$50:

Fall shares consist of storage items including, Brussels spouts, winter squash, cabbage, potatoes, parsnips, apples, popcorn and dry beans. Pick up 2 times November and December.



ADDITIONAL OPTIONS:

EGG SHARE:

Our eggs come from Land of Goshen. We love their free range eggs! Naturally fed, cage free eggs.

EVERY OTHER WEEK, 1 dozen or 1/2 dozen.
1 dozen/bi-weekly \$32
1/2 dozen/bi-weekly \$16

Total of 8 weeks of eggs.
